- Talk about the value of everyone's unique call (use "many gifts, one body" reference from 1 Corinthians 12)
- What is a vocation to the religious life? (briefly describe what that means)

Personal Witness (10 minutes)

- Incorporate one scripture passage or Catechism references that speak to you in this part
- When did you first encounter Christ?
- How did that encounter lead you into a closer relationship with him?
- What led you to your vocation?
- How do you take up your cross and follow Christ?
- What struggles do you face in your vocation?
- How does your vocation help you strive for sainthood?
- Incorporate a life of a saint that you personally connect with

Closing (5 minutes)

Talk about some practical ways to discern your vocation

Song Reflection (5 minutes)

 At the end of your reflection, play/sing as a group a song of your choice (this should tie in with your talk)
